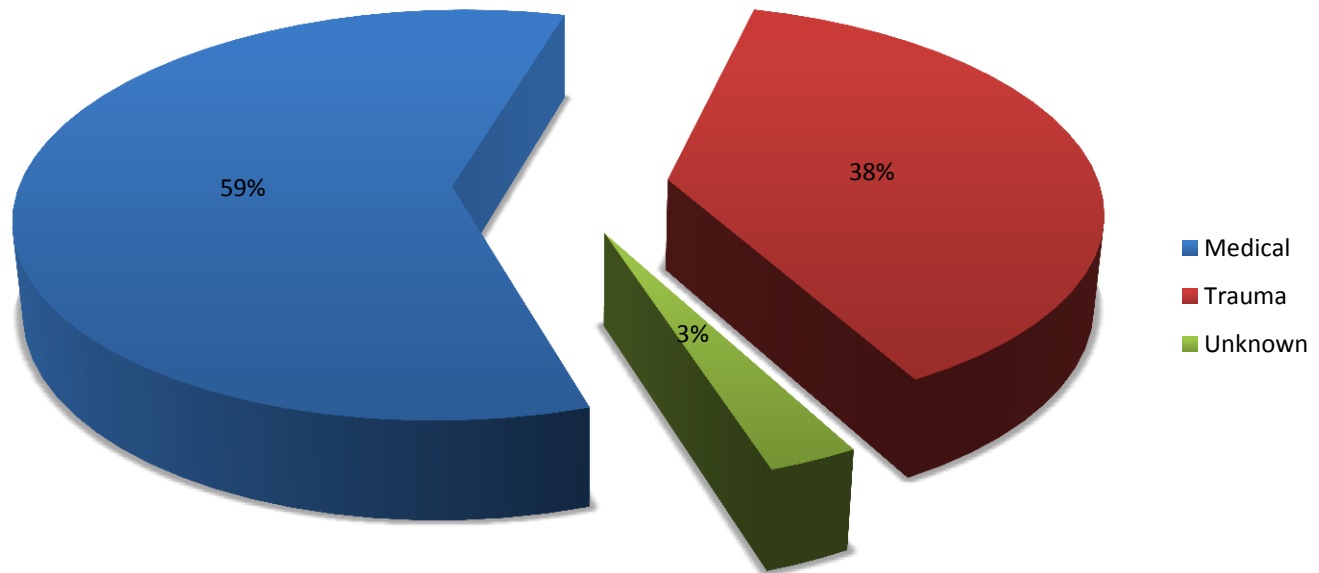
Trauma on Fishing Vessels



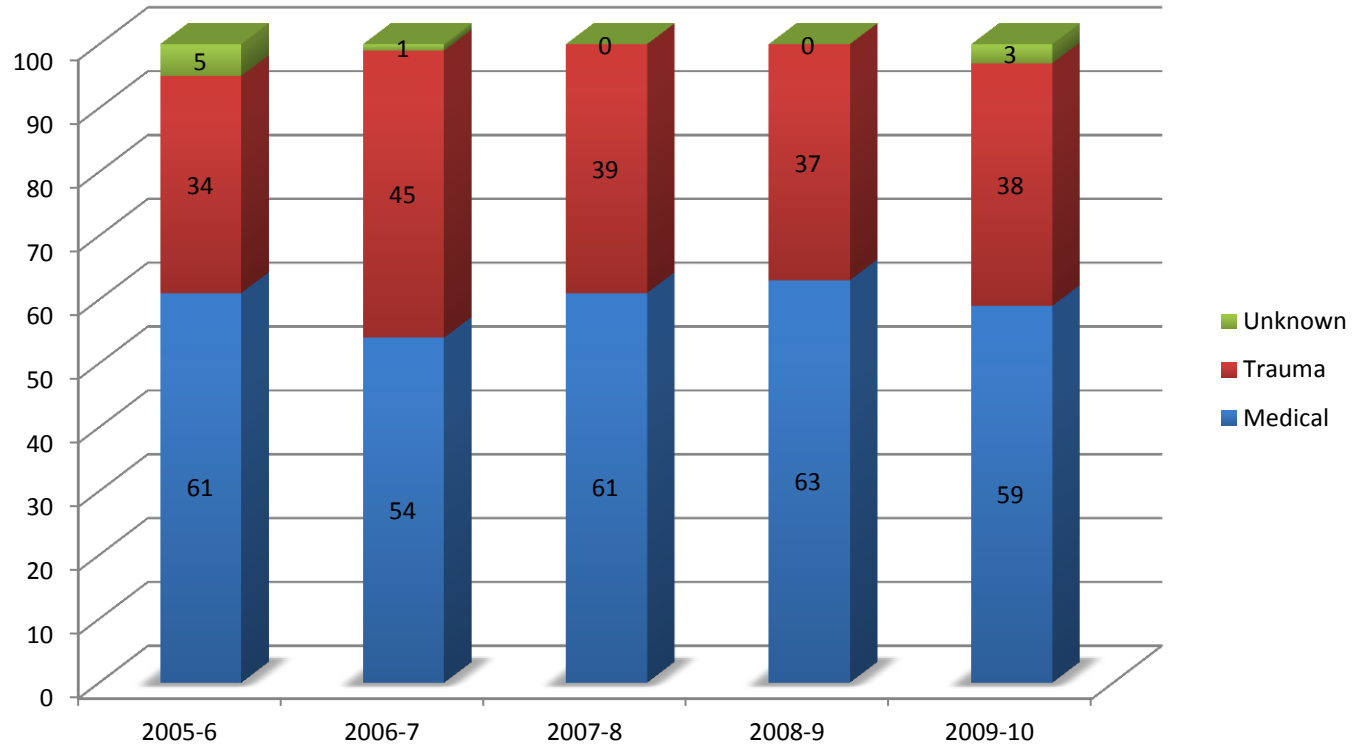
All Vessels 2009-10



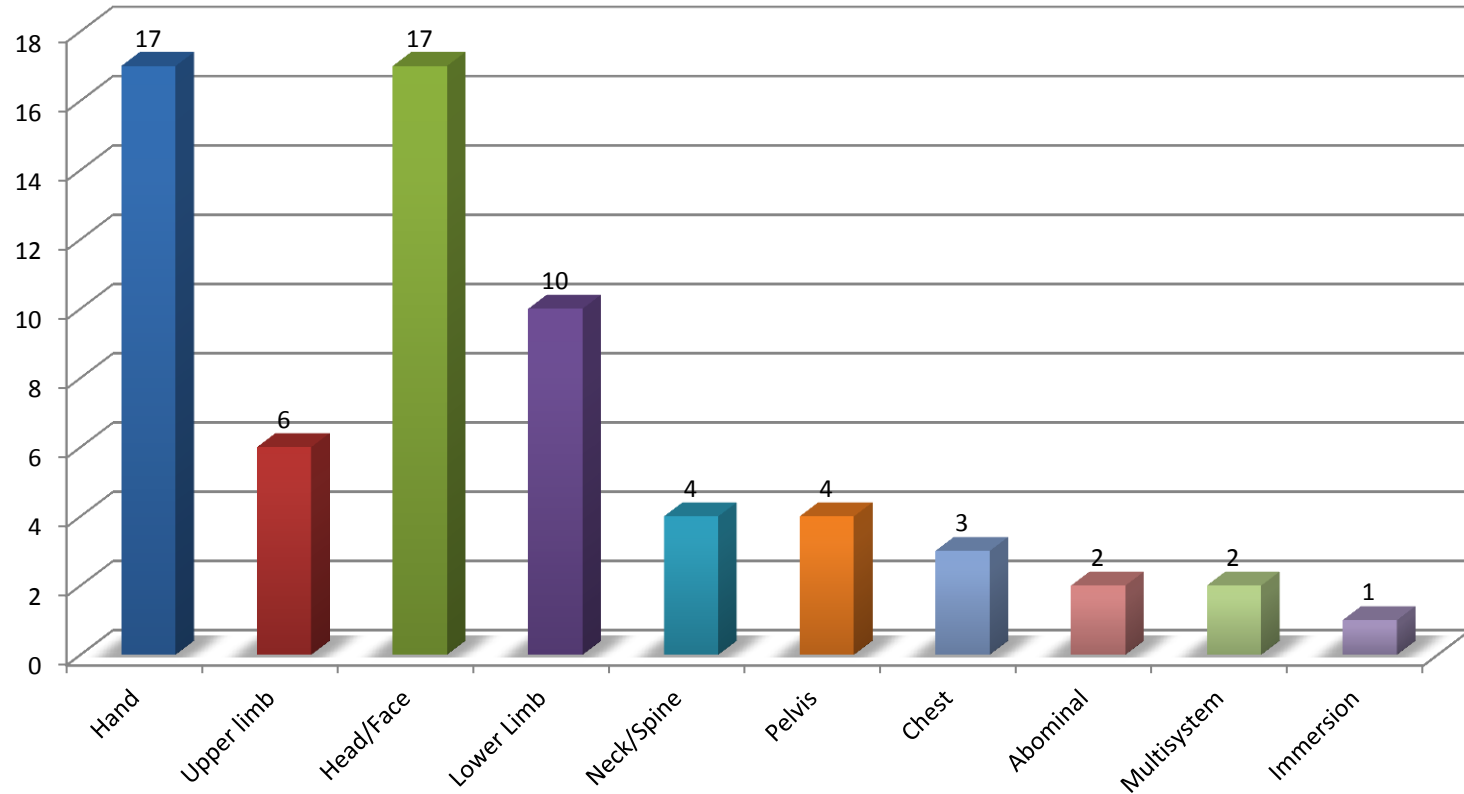

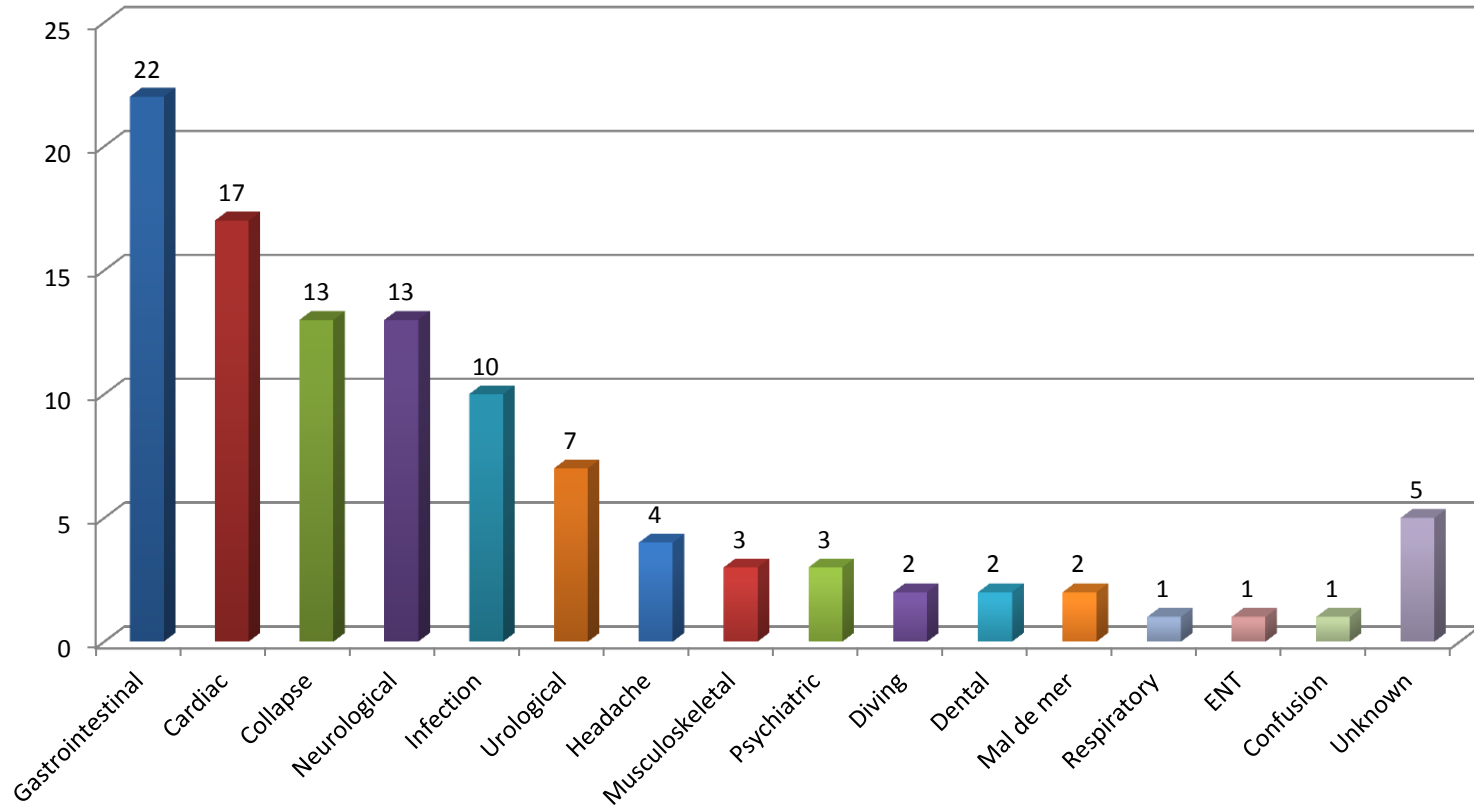
Last 5 Years
