Corporate Manslaughter and Corporate Homicide Act 2007
An organisation to which this section applies is guilty of an offence if the way in which its activities are <u>managed</u> or <u>organised</u> -


- (a) causes a person's death, and
- (b) amounts to a gross breach of a relevant duty of care owed by the organisation to the deceased


