### Award for Maritime Safety

This award is for an individual(s) or team who have demonstrated a passion for safety, leads by example, and continuously strives for safe operations which has had a positive influence on the safety culture, behaviours and or performance in a maritime environment.

#### Entry Criteria

- Candidates should be a seafarer currently serving onboard a vessel actively engaged in supporting the offshore sector, who has made a demonstrably positive impact on the safety culture onboard the vessels upon which they serve.
- Candidates should be nominated by their employing company, ship mates, supported offshore installation or client being served.
- Anyone filling the above can apply for this award, regardless of seniority.

#### Judging Criteria

- Examples of how the individual/team has improved safety culture onboard the vessels they serve or the wider work being carried out by the vessel.
- Examples of how the individual/team has positively changed attitudes of fellow crew members.
- Evidence of how this has had a positive effect on the vessels or company's safety performance.
