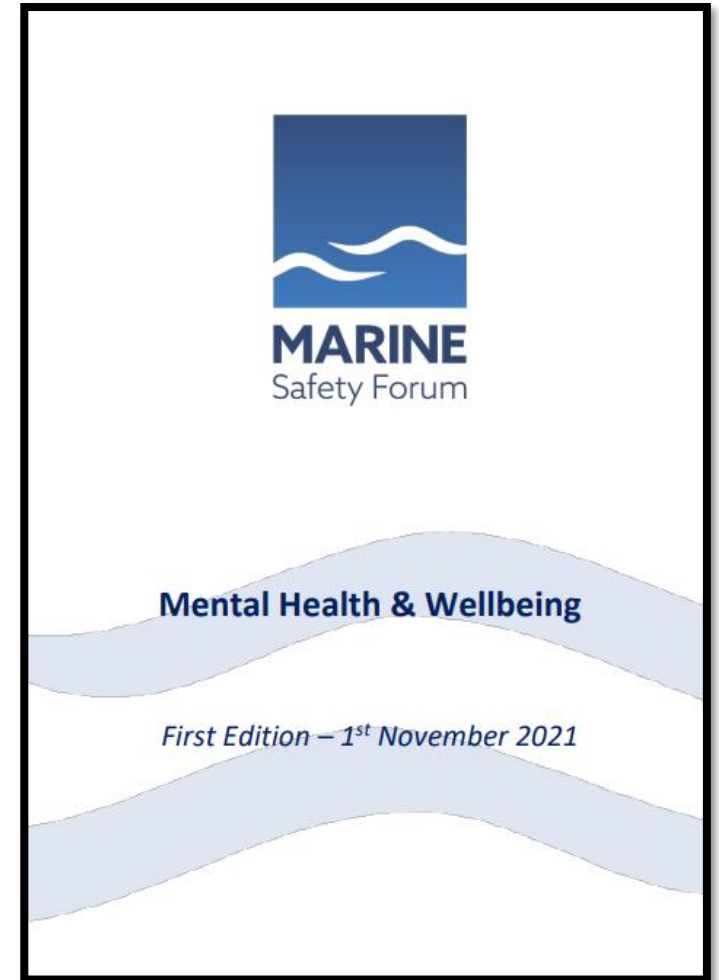
- The fire alarm is a continuous siren. If you hear this alarm, please leave the building by the nearest safe exit

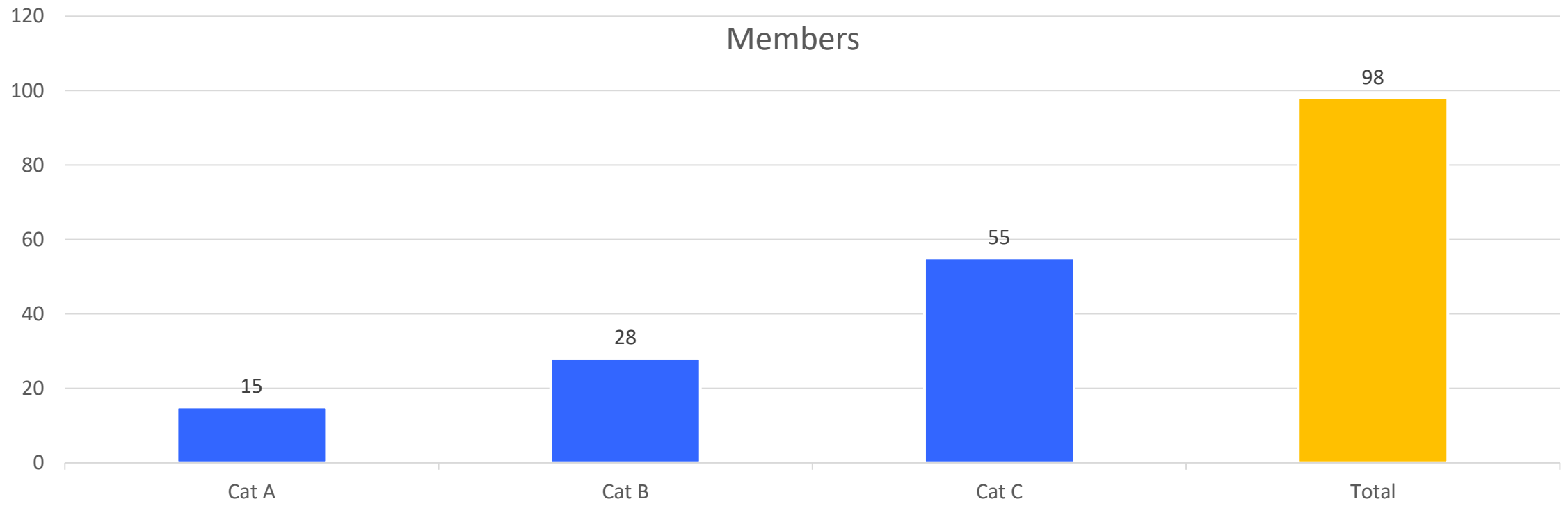

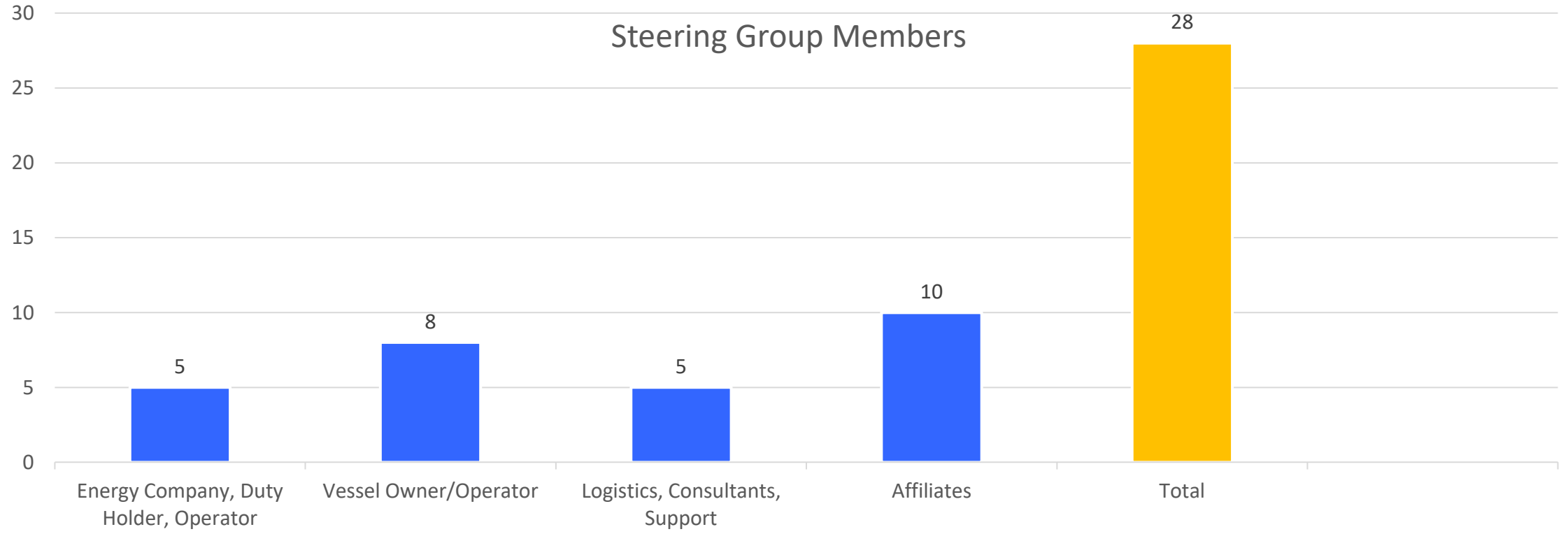

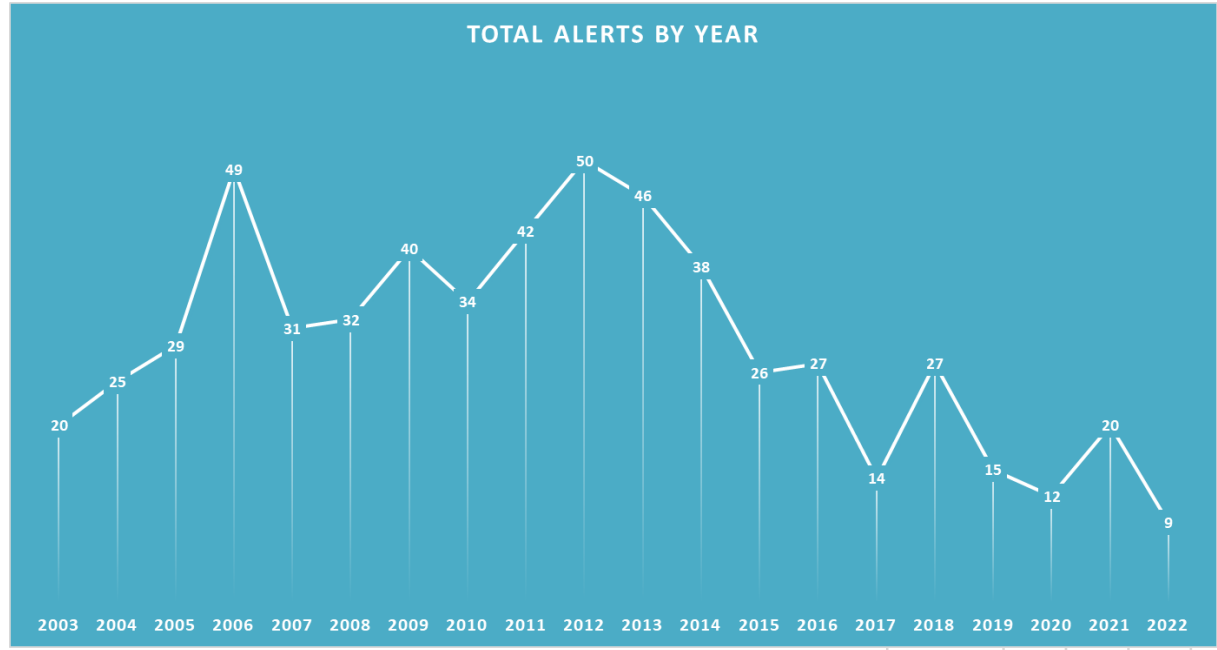
MSF Company Update

- Funds to be put to good use while keeping adequate reserve

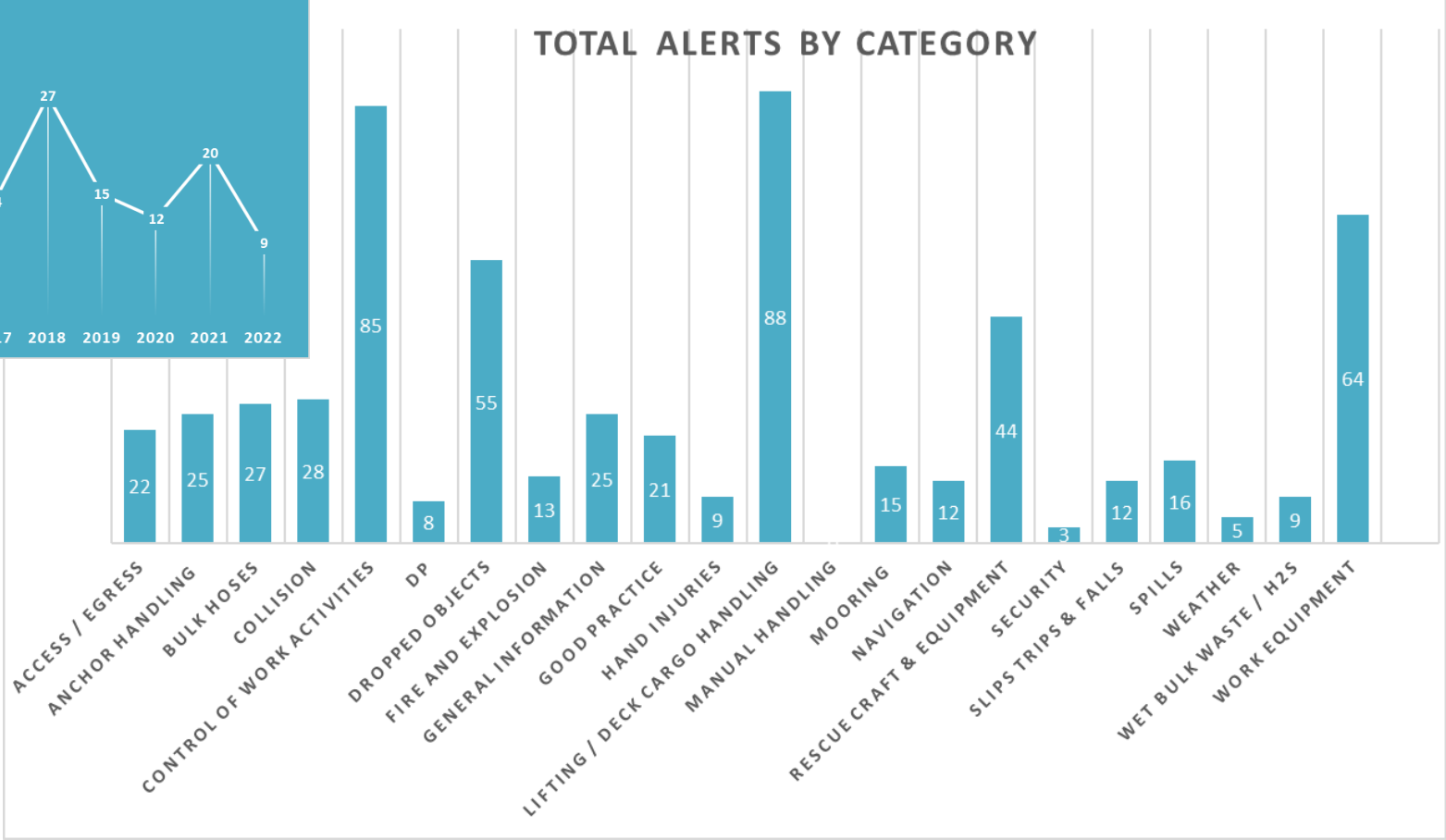

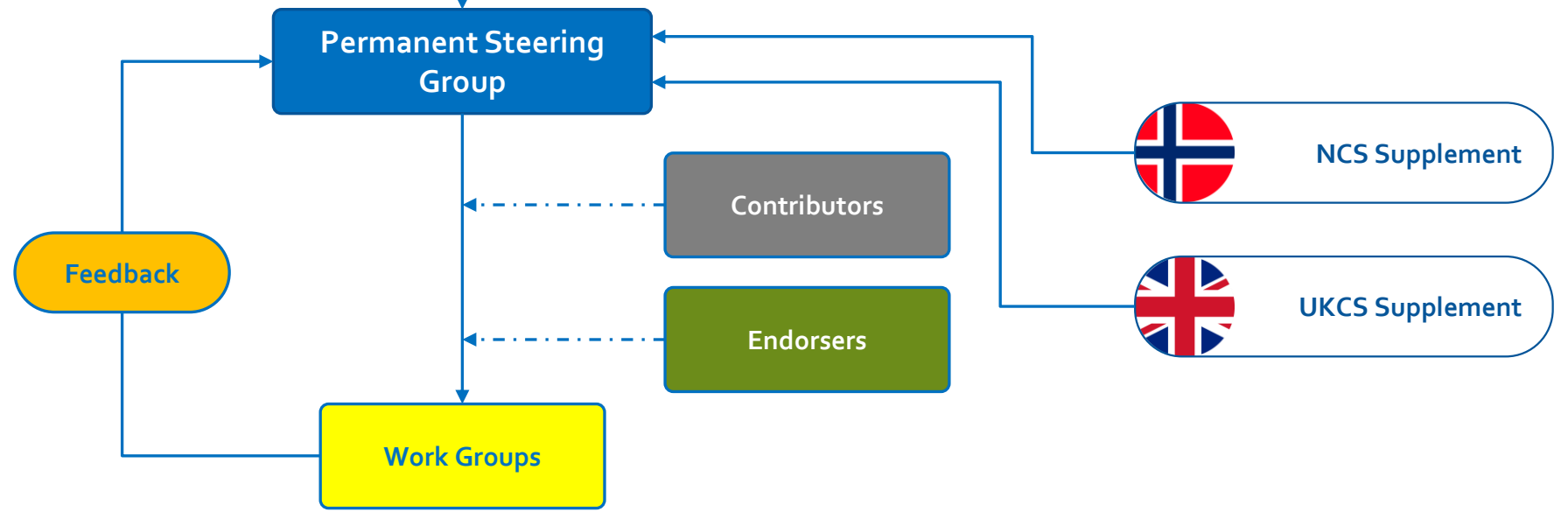
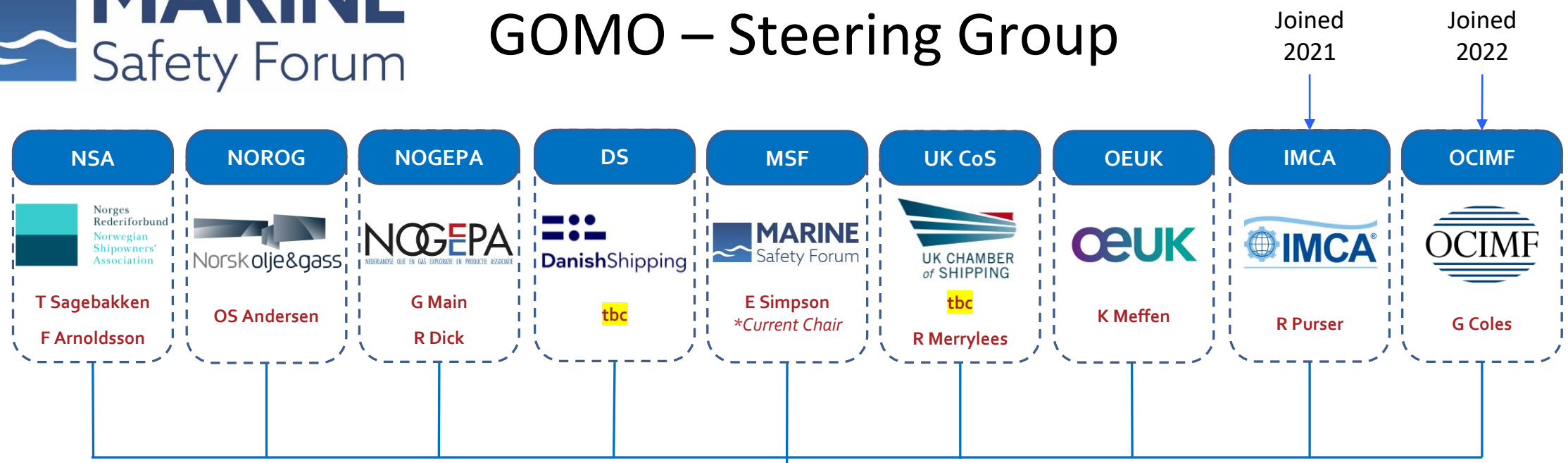
TOTAL ALERTS BY YEAR

GOMO – Current Activity

- Chapter 10 “Bulk Cargo Operations” + associated appendices – almost ready to send to Technical Author
 - Challenges related to wording at 10.2 bullet 14: *“Compressed air should not be used to clear hoses used for the transfer of any hydrocarbon based products since an increased risk of explosion will result”*
- Chapter 11 “Anchor Handling & MOU Moving” workgroup underway, review scope includes:
 - Pre-lay systems and quick release systems
 - Deep water moorings and the use of swivels
 - Inclusion of towing and mooring practices for offshore wind
- Work to start on revision / update of front matter, chapters 1 and 2 + associated appendices
- Website updates and refresh being looked at, may require a change of provider
