

## **Safety Alert**

### Number: 20-19 Subject: Potential Dropped Object

#### What Happened / Narrative

4kg Shackle left on top of a backloaded mud skip.

After removing the lashings from backloaded cargo to be ready for discharge in port, a large 4kg shackle was placed on top of a mud skip by vessel crew and was forgotten about with the unit subsequently being discharged to shore. One day later the question was asked to the vessel if the shackle belonged to them.

#### Why Did it Happen / Cause

The vessel confirmed the shackle was theirs and that it had been left on top of the skip after the lashings were removed to prepare cargo for discharge.

A lack of awareness and rushing the job resulted in the shackle being forgotten about.

#### **Corrective Actions Taken / Recommendations**

An immediate Time Out For Safety was held and the hazards of potential dropped objects were discussed, this information was placed in the handover notes to ensure all personnel were made aware.

A fleet circular was issued to highlight this issue across the vessel owner's own fleet.


