- *To develop, review and publish industry guidelines*

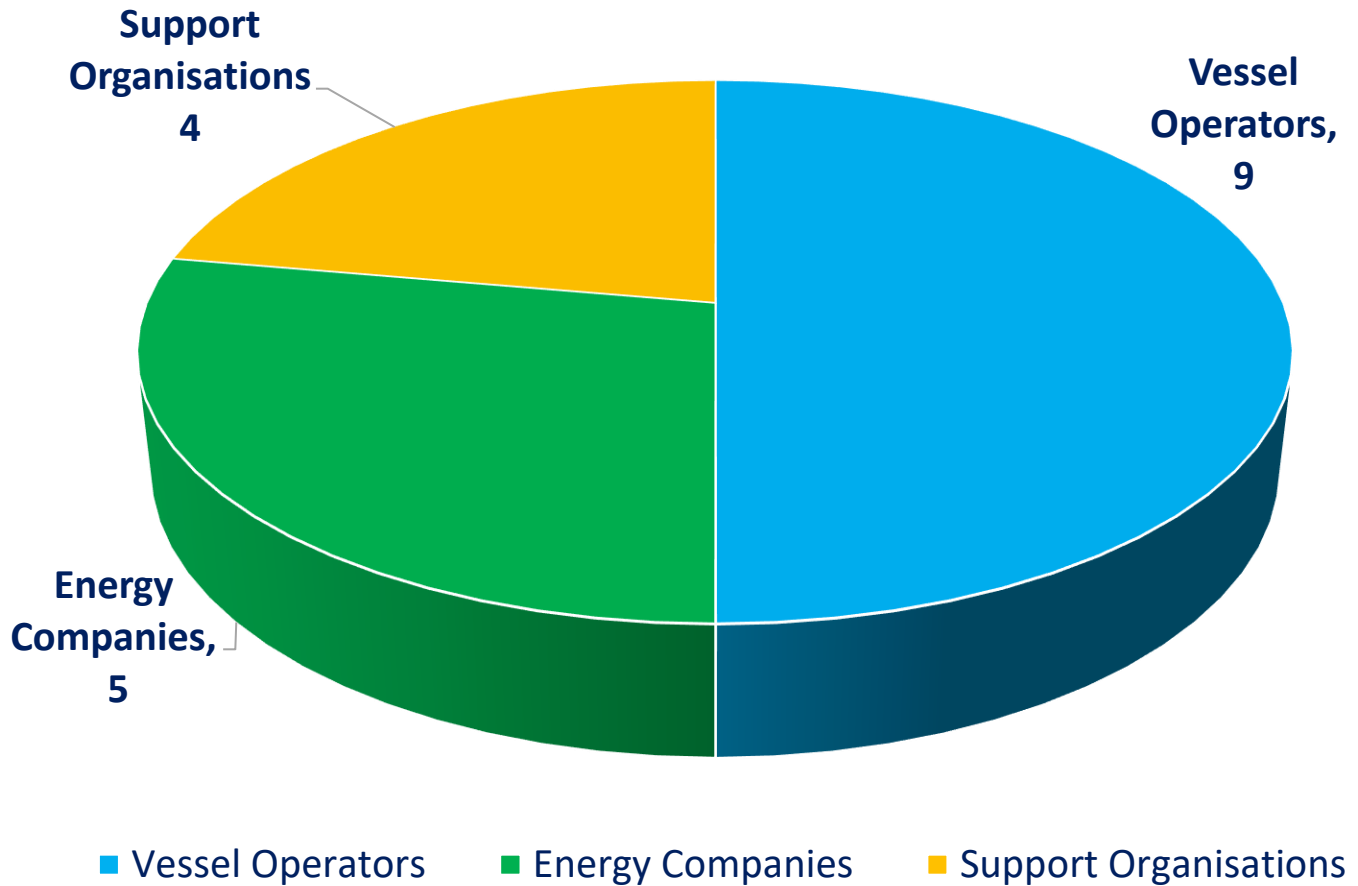
